| <b>PURPOSE</b>          | To help Christians who are seeking a deeper commitment to the Lord and who desire to be more effective in serving Him.   |
| <b>CONTENT</b>          | There will be teaching under the anointing of the Holy Spirit, to enable us to have fresh revelation of our security in Christ. Also to recognise within our own lives, areas of pain still locked in memories from the past. It will help us discern places where we are living in unhelpful habit patterns. These can be a means of protection from further pain or imposed on us from other people. Teaching will also highlight where we react in sinful ways and where the enemy may have a hold. You will receive personal ministry from two or three prayer ministers for three to four hours. You will also have opportunity to take part in the prayer support while others are receiving ministry. |
| <b>REQUIREMENT</b>      | To safeguard this ministry within the life of the Church, applicants will be required to obtain a written recommendation from their Minister or Pastor.  |
| <b>COMMITMENT</b>       | To attend all the sessions because the whole course is progressive. Each session will build on the preceding one and be a preparation for the personal ministry that will be received.   |
